

The Wedding Garment Ordained by YHWH



The Law of the Tallit

"The Kingdom of YHWH is compared to a certain king who gave a WEDDING FEAST for his SON..When the king came in to see the guests, he saw there a man who did not have on a WEDDING GARMENT-TALLIT, and he said to him: Friend, how did you get in here without having a wedding garment? But the man had nothing to say. Then the king said to his servants: Bind him hand and foot, take him away, and cast him into outer darkness...MANY are called but FEW are chosen"-Matt.22:1,10-14

The greatest wedding feast of all time is about to take place for YHWH's Son, and many will be left out because of rejecting the Law of the Tallit-this royal wedding garment ordained by YHWH! Obeying YHWH's every word (Matt.4:4) teaches us His perfect righteous character (2Tim.3:16) and makes us qualified to reign with Yahsha Messiah on earth as His Bride-the Melchizedek Priesthood - the 144,000! The Enemy does NOT want you to reign as a king in YHWH's family, so he has hidden this vital information from you! Discover the power given to those who wear YHWH's garment of righteousness! *Rejecting the Law of the Tallit is rejecting YHWH's son Yahsha Messiah!*

PROVING THE SAINTS

"Your people will have proved themselves obedient to Torah on the day You go forth in power. They will unite with You - arrayed in their Tallits!"

- Psalms 110:3

We live in a world where people are guided by their own foolishness - never considering that the Creator has the better way! Few even understand that this life is a TESTING ground, *"Fear not, for YHWH has come to test you...to know what is in your heart."* (Exodus 20:20; Deut.8:1-3; 1Chron. 28:9). Many professing "christians", including Sabbatarians and "Sacred Name" groups willingly accept man's oppressive laws & idolatrous pagan traditions but REFUSE to accept one or more of YHWH's loving laws, such as the Law of the Tallit! Those who refuse this ordained wedding garment have FAILED His test and CANNOT be chosen as Yahsha's Bride - Priests and Kings in His coming Kingdom (Isa.2:2-4; Hos 4:6; Matt. 5:19; 7:21-23) Those teaching YHWH's Laws of love want freedom for all! (Yaaqob/James 2:12)

"So we will keep your Law forever!

We walk at LIBERTY because we keep your precepts." - Psalms 119:44-45

THE ROBE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

"I will greatly rejoice in YHWH...for He has clothed me with the garments of salvation - He has covered me with the robe of righteousness."

- Ishayah 61:10

It is YHWH who writes Torah on our hearts (Heb.8:8-11). Yahsha Messiah declared His delight to do YHWH's will (Ps.40:8) magnifying the Torah (Isa.42:21) and "sealing" the Torah on His Apostles (Isa.8:16). This includes the Law of the Tallit! In obedience, Yahsha wore this royal robe of righteousness and so did His Apostles. Just as the righteous prophets before them, they were able to perform awe-inspiring miracles - including RAISING THE DEAD! Obedience



brings YHWH's authority, thus His power!

"All scripture is given by inspiration of YHWH, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness..."

- 2 Tim. 3:16

Since "righteousness" is defined in the Torah as being faithful to perform all YHWH's laws, statutes and judgments (Deut. 6:25) wrapping ourselves in the Tallit symbolizes our being covered in His righteousness. We must be faithful to "wear" His righteousness, or we will not be protected during the Great Tribulation! (Ps.91:1-4)

"Who are these arrayed in white robes-Tallits, and where did they come from?...and Yahsha said to me, These are the ones who came out of the Great Tribulation, and have washed their Tallits, and made themselves white in the blood of the Lamb." - Rev.7:13-14

MANTLE OF YHWH'S SERVANTS

"Fifty men of the sons of the prophets came and stood at a distance watching them, while the two of them stood by the Yordan river. Then Yliyah removed his mantle-Tallit, rolled it up, and struck the water with it. The water then separated to the right and to the left, and the two of them crossed over on dry ground."

- 2 Kings 2:7-8

The prophets Samuyl, Yliyah and Ylisha are each noted in scripture as wearing a Tallit. Most English versions designate it as a "mantle". King Shaul tore Samuyl's Tallit (1 Sam. 15:27-28) and recognized Samuyl especially because of his Tallit (1 Sam. 28:14). The mantle of Yliyah is more famous. The Hebrew word used of Yliyah's Tallit is *adaret*. Adaret comes from *adayr* which is one of the many Hebrew words for majesty and honor.

Many exploits and miracles of Yliyah & Ylisha were recorded to show YHWH's power performed through the Tallit. Yliyah used his Tallit at the Yordan River to re-enact the miracle of the Red Sea crossing. Ylisha then repeated the same event

after receiving Yliyah's Tallit and the prophet's sons bowed down to him (2 Kings 2:14-15). The authority of YHWH resides in this royal garment!

This is evident in the ordination of Ylisha when "Yliyah passed by him and cast his mantle-*adaret*-Tallit upon him.." (1 Kings 19:19) It is believed that the Tallit of Yliyah, after being passed down through several prophets, was then preserved by the priesthood - the sons of Zadok. Zecharyah, the father of Yahchanan the Immerser (John the Baptist), was of these Levitical priests. Records have been discovered which indicate that these faithful sons of Zadok were exiled by Herod and joined the Qumran community where the Dead Sea scrolls were found. It is probable that Yahchanan himself, a Levitical priest of the lineage of Zadok, came into possession of Yliyah's Tallit! His ministry was also centered around the Yordan close to the Qumran area (Luke 3:3) Luke 1:17 shows Gabriyl's prophecy that the Messiah's 2nd cousin - Yahchanan the Immerser would come forth...

"in the SPIRIT & AUTHORITY of Yliyah"

This is a fact proven by the spiritual character and authority of his ministry, but may also allude to the possibility that he wore Yliyah's very Tallit!

The Israyl of YHWH is called a "kingdom of priests" (Ex.19:6) and is commanded to wear royal robes called *ha'adaret* - the royal Tallit!

THE LAW OF THE TALLIT

"Speak unto the Sons of Israyl and bid them that they make fringes-tsitsit in the borders of their Tallits throughout their generations, and that they put upon the fringe of the borders a cord of blue: And it shall be unto you for a fringe-tzitzit that you will look upon it and REMEMBER ALL THE COMMANDMENTS of YHWH, and DO THEM...and be set apart unto YHWH."

- Numbers 15:38-40

"You must make fringes (tsitsit) upon the four corners of your vesture-Tallit you cover yourself with..." - Deuteronomy 22:12

The beauty and symbolism surrounding the Tallit has been lost amongst most non-Jewish believers. Babylonian christianity has hidden this jewel from humanity far too long! The Law is plain that the Tallit with the fringes in its four corners is a commandment to



“Ben Israyl” or the Sons of Israyl (which includes of course Gentiles grafted into the Covenant of Israyl thru Yahsha ha’ Meshiyakh.) Taking these two commandments together, YHWH instructs His Sons to remind themselves of His Laws by placing a fringe (Heb. *tzitzit*) in each corner (Heb. *kanaf*-wing) of their Tallit. The statute requires each *tzitzit* to contain a blue cord (Num. 15:38). This blue thread (the color of royalty) of the fringe-*tzitzit* symbolizes Yahsha the servant king.

Yahsha Messiah who wraps in unity the other white cords (symbolizing His people) in YHWH’s Name (Mal.4:2; Yahch.17:11-12). These *tzitzits* were points of miraculous healing powers during Yahsha’s ministry. They were also the focus of a warning given by Yahsha. The Messiah rebuked the pride of the self-righteous Pharisees saying, “But all their works they do to be seen of men; they enlarge the borders (Grk. *kraspedon* - *tzitzit*) of their garments (Grk. *himation* - tallits). He knew the self-righteous did not use the Law of the Tallit to come humbly before YHWH. Question: Are you showing inward integrity in connection with your outward show of obedience to YHWH?

THE TALLIT OF YAHSHA



“But for you who revere My Name (YHWH), the light of righteousness will **ARISE** with healing in its wings (Heb. *kanfot* of the Tallit)” - Malakyah 4:2

It is certain that Yahsha, who revered YHWH, wore the Tallit simply because He was obedient to every commandment of the Torah, He being without sin (1 J. 3:4). Beginning His ministry at age 30 (Matt.3:23), Yahsha was immersed and

ordained - given authority by YHWH thru the Tallit-wearing Levitical priest Yahchanan...

“And Yahsha, when He was immersed, came up immediately from the water; and lo, the heavens were opened to Him, and He saw the Spirit of YHWH coming down and wrapping around Him as the wings of a dove (the Tallit of Yahchanan).” Then lo, a voice from heaven saying (in Hebrew): This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.” - Matt.3:16-17.

The richness of Hebrew symbolism for the Tallit is lost by the mistranslated Greek texts of the original Hebrew Testimonies (gospels). The Tallit, having four corners or wings, is given as a type of YHWH’s Spirit. V.16 in the KJV is translated “like a dove” from the Greek *peristera*. This should be translated “the wrap-around as wings”. Again, the “wings” or *kanfot* of the Tallit is revealed - even in Yahsha’s ordination by YHWH! These wings were the four corners of His Tallit! It is YHWH’s Spirit that dispenses the gift of healing, so it’s no surprise that Yahsha fulfilled Mal. 4:2 and performed great healings with His “winged” Tallit. Note how the following King James Version MIS-translation HIDES the truth of the Tallit’s miraculous power.



“Then behold, a woman with an issue of blood twelve years came up behind Him, and touched the hem (Grk# 2899 *kraspedon* - Heb# 6734 *tzitzit*, see Thayer’s Greek English Lexicon to the New Testament p.358) of His garment (Grk# 2440 *himation* - mantle-Tallit, see Thayers) For she said to herself; If only I can touch His garment (tallit) I shall be whole. and immediately her issue of blood stopped...Yahsha said, I perceive POWER has gone out from Me...and said unto her, Your faith has made you whole.” - Matt.9:20-22 and Luke 8:42-48

Episodes of healing thru the “wings” of the Tallit were common occurrences in Yahsha’s ministry!

“And wherever Yahsha entered...they laid the sick in the streets, and besought Him that they might touch just the hem-TZITZIT of His garment-TALLIT. And as many as touched Him were made whole.” - Mark 6:56

When Yahsha went to the ruler of the synagogue’s house to heal his sick daughter, they found she had died (Mark 5:35-43). Then Yahsha...

“took the child by the hand, and said to her, *Talitha kumi: which is being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto thee, ARISE.* And straightway the damsel arose.” This later inserted interpretation is incorrect because “Talitha” is NOT Hebrew for damsel. Instead, it is a form of the word TALLIT! Therefore, a more accurate translation of “Talitha kumi” should be “Arise with My Tallit!” which now gives a dramatic picture of Yahsha raising her up as He RAISED His TALLIT heavenward! The power of Yahsha’s Tallit brought her back from the dead! These were just some of the miraculous healings performed by Yahsha - Israyl’s only true Messiah and King fulfilling Malakyah 4:2...

“...ARISE with HEALING in HIS WINGS...”

THE SEAMLESS GARMENT

“You shall keep my statutes...a garment of mingled linen and wool shall not come upon you” - Leviticus 19:19

A Tallit, therefore, must be made of only one kind of cloth in order to satisfy the statute (Deut. 22:11). By making the Tallit of one cloth without seams, there can be no accidental mixture of materials. Thus, the Tallit also reminds us of the unchangeableness of YHWH - the same from beginning to end “For I am YHWH, I change not” (Mal. 3:6). It appears that Yahsha’s Tallit was seamless, in obedience to this statute. For in the account of His execution, the Apostle notes that Yahsha’s Tallit “was without seam, woven from top to bottom” - Yahchanan 19:23. When the Roman soldiers saw its quality, the prophecy in Psalms 22:18 came true, “For My vesture - Tallit

they did cast lots” v.24. As Yahsha wore the Tallit and obeyed all the righteous requirements of His Father YHWH, He ultimately offered Himself as the perfect Lamb (Yahch.1:29; 1 Keph/Peter 1:19). One word for lamb in Hebrew is *talah* (Heb#2922) from which Tallit has been taken, and means: to cover for protection - as in the blood of a lamb at Passover. As we “cover” ourselves in obedience to YHWH’s Law of the Tallit, we are thereby being “covered” in the blood of the Lamb - Yahsha ha’ Meshiyakh! Yahsha Himself, as the Lamb of YHWH is like the perfect unmingled woolen Tallit. The spotless Lamb, who thru His death has “covered” the sins of those who repent for breaking YHWH’s Covenant Laws, including the Law of the Tallit! If you’re not “covered” in the Tallit - you’re NOT COVERED by His blood!



“He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High will abide under the Tallit of the Almighty...YHWH will cover you with His feathers, and under His wings (Heb. *Kanfot* - corners of the Tallit) will you trust...Because you have made YHWH your refuge and have made the Most High your abode, no evil will befall you, nor will any plague come near your dwelling...Because you know My Name you will call me and I will answer.. and I will show you My Salvation - Yahsha ha’ Meshiyakh!” - Ps.91

THE WEDDING DAY!

That day is fast approaching, and everyone is invited! YHWH’s Son will marry a spotless Bride who will reign with Him in *majestic splendor* arrayed in Tallits of white! On that day...Will you be wearing your wedding garment - the Tallit?
